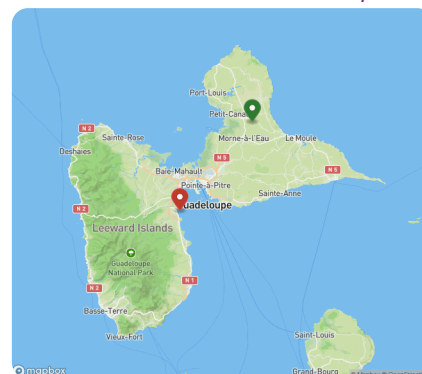

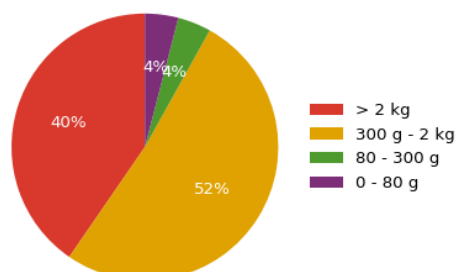
Potential yield by site and year
